

Festivals are perceived as important part of education as they can help to create a sense of nationalism among students. Celebration of festivals bring students closer to traditional belief.


Keeping this in view, Great Ganges Institute of Technology, Unnao celebrated Eid Milad Un-Nabi with great pomp and show.

Diwali Celebration


November 12th, 2023



January 24th, 2024


